Block Party Permit Application

Requirements and Guidelines

- 1.** Complete the City of Cuyahoga Falls “Block Party Permit Application.” Applications shall be filed no less than ten days before the time of the requested closure.
- 2.** Complete the attached “Block Party Barricade Deposit Form.” The Street Department will drop off the required barricades the Friday before the event and will pick up the following Monday.
- 3.** Collect signatures from one (1) adult who resides at each home whose driveway access will be affected by the closure. Please note: you are required to obtain signatures from at least 60% of the homes affected.
- 4.** A \$50 equipment deposit is required in the form of a check or money order (we cannot accept cash) made payable to: The City of Cuyahoga Falls. The deposit must be received no less than ten days before the time of requested closure. If you have any questions, please call: (330) 971-8208.
