

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2013, the Planning Commission approved the issuance of a conditional zoning certificate for the operation of an outdoor bulk storage facility at 4575 State Road (Parcel No. 35-01025), in an E-1 Employment District within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:


