Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic 25 26 Control File is hereby amended as follows: 27 Prohibit parking on the odd side of Cook Street between 2005 & 2013 28 (1)Cook Street. 29 Prohibit parking on the even side of Liberty Street from 2180 Liberty 30 (2)Street to the corner of Center Street. 31 32 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in 33 the Traffic Control File the proper legends. 34 35 36 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments. 37 38 39 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances 40 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent 41 herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and 42 43 confirmed. 44 45 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an 46 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of 47 48 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 49

of the Codified Ordinances.
