5 ORDINANCE NO. 122 - 2022

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH
9 HASENSTAB ARCHITECTS FOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES
10 RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW FIRE STATION 4
11 CAMPUS, INCLUDING A TRAINING FACILITY AND FIRE PROP, AND
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, Fire Station 4 is outdated and in need of replacement and demolition, necessitating
15 architectural design services; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the City followed the procedures set forth in Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.65 to 153.73
18 in selecting a professional design services firm to assist with the project; and

19
20 WHEREAS, after review of all the proposals submitted to the City, Hasenstab Architects was selected
21 as the most qualified for the project.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
24 and State of Ohio, that:

26 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts
27 with Hasenstab Architects for architectural design services related to the construction of the new Fire
28 Station 4 campus, including a training facility and fire prop.

29
30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from
31 the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, line item, Capital Outlay.



33 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
34 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
35 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

37 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
38 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations
39 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to
40 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the
41 Codified Ordinances.

43 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
44 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
45 inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
46 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
47 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
