ORDINANCE NO. - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH QUALITY FABRICATION & ASSEMBLY, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE, CUTTING, AND FABRICATION OF STAINLESS STEEL, TO BE UTILIZED IN A PUBLIC ART SCULPTURE DESIGNED BY LOCAL ARTIST DON DRUMM, AND TO BE INSTALLED IN HIGH BRIDGE GLENS PARK LOCATED AT 1817 FRONT STREET, AND MAKING THE **NECESSARY** APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is the recipient of a donation from Don Drumm, a local artist, that consists of the design for a public art sculpture to be installed in High Bridge Glens Park located at 1817 Front Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls solicited a quotes, without competitive bidding, for the purchase, cutting, and fabrication of stainless steel to construct the public art sculpture designed by Don Drumm; and

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development and said funds can be used to improve public facilities, including the creation and installation of public art located in low-to-moderate income areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to enter into separate agreements with Quality Fabrication & Assembly, LLC for the purchase, cutting, and fabrication of stainless steel to be used in constructing the public art sculpture designed by Don Drumm; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funding will be utilized for the fabrication portion of the agreement with Quality Fabrication & Assembly, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Quality Fabrication & Assembly, LLC, as a local fabricator capable of saving costs of transportation in erecting the public art sculpture once constructed, represents a specialized vendor such that the City is not required to secure competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into separate agreements with Quality Fabrication & Assembly, LLC, for the purchase and cutting of stainless steel in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00, and for fabrication in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, for its construction of a public art sculpture designed by Don Drumm, a local artist, to be installed in High Bridge Glens Park located at 1817 Front Street.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Capital Outlay and reduce appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Other Operations in the amount of \$65,000.00. Furthermore, the Director of Finance is authorized to increase appropriations in the Capital Fund, line item Capital Outlay in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is authorized to make payment from the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Capital Outlay in the amount of \$65,000.00 and the Capital Fund, line item Capital Outlay in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00.

Section 4. The Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Community Development, Director of Law, and any other public officials, individually and/or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents and do all other things as are necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of this legislation.

Section 5. Any ordinance or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 7. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
