AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ISSUE A REIMBURSEMENT TO PRINCETON CROSSROADS INVESTMENT, LLC FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CLUBHOUSE FOR THE PRINCETON PLACE DEVELOPMENT, INCREASING **APPROPRIATIONS** THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an "In Lieu of Dedication" fee of \$600 per dwelling unit was collected from Princeton Crossroads, LLC according to the procedures set forth in 1124.05; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a clubhouse that serves the Princeton Place subdivision is an acceptable use of an "In Lieu of Dedication" payment according to Section 1124.05 (D)(2); and

WHEREAS, Princeton Crossroads, LLC constructed a clubhouse within the Princeton Place development at a cost of \$549,000, and has requested reimbursement of the "In Lieu of Dedication" fees collected by the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to issue a reimbursement payment of \$90,000 to Princeton Crossroads, LLC.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund, line-item Capital Outlay in the amount of \$90,000, and make payment for same.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
