7 AN ORDINANCE INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL
8 PROJECTS FUND FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF WEST PORTAGE TRAIL,
9 FROM STATE ROAD TO NORTHAMPTON ROAD AND DECLARING AN
10 EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, Article VI, Sections 7 and 8 of the City Charter provide that City Council may revise, amend,
13 and supplement budgetary appropriations during the fiscal year, and may authorize the transfer of
14 unencumbered appropriations within various accounts; and

15
16 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10-2023 authorized the Director of Public Services to enter into contracts for
17 the improvement of Portage Trail Extension West, from State Road to Northampton Rd; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Ordinance 128-2023 reduced appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund due to the
20 accounting adjustments necessary to certify 2023 estimated resources with the Summit County Budget
21 Commission.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
24 and State of Ohio, that:



26 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to appropriate funds to the Capital Projects
27 Fund line item Capital Outlay for the improvement of West Portage Trail, from State Road to Northampton
28 Road in the amount of \$4,418,856.00.

30 Section 2. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
31 herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
32 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

34 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
35 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
36 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
37 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the
38 Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
41 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
42 inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or
43 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
44 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
