## Temp. Ord. B-10

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for repair and resurfacing of Tallmadge Road from Newberry Street to a point 300' south of Clyde Avenue, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that in 2011, the City applied for federal funds and was awarded \$391,000 for this project, which covers 80%. This will be the seventh major roadway the City has improved with AMATS funds since 2010. Tallmadge Road was last paved in 1996. Work will begin after June 8 and be completed before August 22. They want to do the work during school summer recess. The project should take four to five weeks. Bids were opened last week. They received seven bids. It will be awarded next week. Mrs. Pyke stated that several people on Tallmadge Road were angry why their street was not getting resurfaced. The City did what it could to extend the life of the street. There will be very happy people on Tallmadge and others in the area now. It is a main street.

Mrs. Pyke moved to bring out B-10 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Ihasz. Motion passed (3-0).
