

**Cuyahoga Falls City Council**  
**Minutes of the Public Improvements Committee Meeting**  
**February 21, 2006**

Mr. James called the meeting to order at 6:29 p.m. Mr. Mader was absent.

The minutes of February 6, 2006 were approved as submitted.

Mr. James said that the following legislation will be held for discussion at a later date: B-174, A-14 and A-15.

**Discussion:**

**Temp. Ord. A-25**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the annual resurfacing and/or repair of various streets as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto in the City of Cuyahoga Falls and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read A-25 (second reading).

Mr. James asked which main roads would be done this year. Mr. Demasi said Portage Trail, Silver Lake, Bailey Road intersection at Munroe Falls, and Phelps Ave.

Mrs. Pyke asked if there were any streets other than Portage Trail that will include a rebuild. Mr. Demasi said not at this time. Mrs. Pyke asked Mr. Demasi for a copy of the curb list.

*The committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. A-25 for approval.*

**Temp. Ord. A-26**

An ordinance amending Chapter 929 of the Codified Ordinances with the addition of Section 929.06, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read A-26 (second reading). Mr. Bell said this is the last of three ordinances to be implemented to satisfy requirements on storm water. It controls what happens to the storm water after construction is finished and the subdivision is in place.

Mrs. Pyke asked if Engineering could provide an updated list of storm water projects. Mr. Bell said yes.

Mr. Nelsch (North Haven Blvd.) asked if there was anything in the ordinance of interest to the Planning Commission. Mr. Bell said developers will have to implement long-term storm water management practices to keep sediment and other materials out of the storm water.
