AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REFUND OF A LANDSCAPE PERFORMANCE BOND TO BATH ROAD ASSOCIATES LLC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City collected a deposit in the form of a landscape performance bond for the French Mill II Development Project; and

WHEREAS, Bath Road Associates LLC has completed the Project, requiring the City of Cuyahoga Falls to return its bond.
