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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION REMEDIATION FUND GRANT FROM THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00 FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION OF A POND AREA LOCATED IN THE PRESERVE AT SALT CREEK RUN DEVELOPMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH PATRIOT ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. TO COMPLETE THE WORK ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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20 21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 3734, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is eligible for and has applied to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) for program funding to implement an Environmental Protection Remediation Fund Grant (Grant); and

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WHEREAS, Buckeye Sports Center's shooting range operated on the site now occupied by the Preserve at Salt Creek Run (Preserve) development from 1961 to 1971, resulting in lead contamination; and

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WHEREAS, the site was remediated in 2013 prior to residential development, however, further remediation of the pond area in the Preserve is necessary; and

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WHEREAS, ORC §3734.281 authorizes the Ohio EPA Director and City to enter into a grant agreement from the environmental protection remediation fund created in ORC §3734.281 to remediate a substantial threat to public health or safety; and

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WHEREAS, the City hired Patriot Engineering and Environmental, Inc. (Patriot) to provide professional services related to the work associated with the grant, including, but not limited to, obtaining quotes for environmental remediation related to the pond area located in the Preserve at Salt Creek Run; and

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WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into these agreements so that work can commence immediately to meet Ohio EPA's deadline.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

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<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with Ohio EPA to accept an Environmental Protection Remediation Fund Grant in the amount of \$200,000.00 for environmental remediation of a pond area located in the Preserve at Salt Creek Run development.

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Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with Patriot Engineering and Environmental, Inc. to complete the work associated with the Grant set forth in Section 1 above.

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Section 3. The Mayor, City Engineer, Director of Law, Director of Finance and other necessary City officials are authorized to provide such information and to execute such other documents and amendments to the agreements and do all other actions as are necessary for and incidental to carrying out the requirements of this ordinance and the terms of the agreements.

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Section 4. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay the City's share of the grant project from the Storm Drainage Fund, line item Other Operations.

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Section 5. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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Section 7. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and the inhabitants thereof, and for further reason that this measure is necessary due to the grant deadline, and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
