6 ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 2007

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
9 FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS  
10 FOR SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE  
11 EGOVERNMENT SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS, AND  
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
13

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
15 County of Summit and State of Ohio:  
16

17 Section 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
18 contracts for software maintenance and support of the eGovernment software and is further  
19 authorized and directed to make payment for same from funds properly appropriated  
20 therefor.  
21

22 Section 2. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
23 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances  
24 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and  
25 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
26

27 Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
28 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting  
29 of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that  
30 resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all  
31 legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


33 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
34 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of  
35 the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
36 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take  
37 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it  
38 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
