7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO
8 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR
9 THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN MATERIALS
10 AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE SANITATION DIVISION DURING 2022,
11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio,
14 that:

15
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
17 according to law, for the purchase of the following materials and supplies for use in the Sanitation Division
18 during 2022:

20 Wheeled Refuse Containers

22 Section 2. Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances,
23 expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed, in the aggregate,
24 \$232,000, without further consent of City Council by ordinance.

25
26 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
27 from the Sanitation Fund, line item Other Operations.



29 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
31 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
32 and confirmed.

33
34 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
35 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
36 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
37 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
41 the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
42 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
43 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
