7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO
8 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR
9 THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES,
10 MATERIALS, AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE GARAGE DIVISION
11 DURING 2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio,
14 that:

15
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
17 according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies and services for use by the Garage Division
18 during 2023:

20 Fuel
21 Tires
22 Repairs
23 Parts

25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from
26 the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.

28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
29 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
33 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations
34 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to
35 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the
36 Codified Ordinances.

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
39 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
40 inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies and services are necessary for the daily functioning of
41 the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
42 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
43 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
