5 ORDINANCE NO 128 - 2022

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO  
8 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR  
9 THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN MATERIALS  
10 AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE STREET DIVISION DURING 2023, AND  
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio,  
14 that:

15  
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,  
17 according to law, for the purchase of the following materials and supplies for use by the Street Division  
18 during 2023:

20 Rock Salt  
21 Asphaltic Products

23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from  
24 the SCMR Fund, line item Other Operations, State Highway Improvement Fund, line item Other Operations,  
25 Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, line item Other Operations and Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital  
26 Outlay.



28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent  
29 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
30 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31  
32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to  
33 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations  
34 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to  
35 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the  
36 Codified Ordinances.

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation  
39 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the  
40 inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or  
41 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the  
42 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
