9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND
10 RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
11 CONTRACTS WITH CARRIER CORPORATION FOR THE
12 PURCHASE OF A 250-TON CHILLER UNIT TO BE
13 INSTALLED AT THE NATATORIUM, AND DECLARING AN
14 EMERGENCY.
15

16 WHEREAS, the purchase by contract of the equipment, services, materials or
17 supplies identified herein is through participation in a contract between the vendor and
18 Sourcewell, a cooperative purchasing group, and is thus exempt from competitive
19 bidding requirements pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §125.04; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the chiller unit at the Natatorium is now over 18 years old and reaching
22 the effective life cycle; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the replacement of the chiller unit, will allow the Natatorium to
25 modernize and replace a failing system.
26

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
28 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
29

30 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a
31 contract or contracts with Carrier Corporation for the purchase of a 250-ton chiller unit
32 to be installed at the Natatorium.
33

34 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
35 from Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

37 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
38 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
39 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
40 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
41

42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
43 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
44 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
45 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
46 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
47 of the Codified Ordinances.
48

49 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
50 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the


51 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
52 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
53 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
54 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
