ORDINANCE NO. 7.2 - 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY FOR THE ABANDONED GAS STATION CLEANUP GRANT PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000.00 FOR THE REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS 1704 S. FRONT STREET (PARCEL 02-04691), CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO 44221, AND TO MAKE THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls applied for a grant through the Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant Program for the real property known as 1704 S. Front Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221 (Parcel 02-04691) on March 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2021, the State of Ohio Controlling Board and the Ohio Development Services Agency awarded the City of Cuyahoga Falls an Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, to be used for assessment activities, closure of underground storage tanks, demolition, and site clearance at the real property known as 1704 S. Front Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay by \$250,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Ohio Development Services Agency for the Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant Program to be used for assessment activities, closure of underground storage tanks, demolition, and site clearance at the real property known as 1704 S. Front Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221 (Parcel 02-04691).
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay by \$250,000 and make payment from the same.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Community Development, Director of Law, and any other public officials, individually or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents and do all other things as necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of the Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant Program.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
- Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
