ORDINANCE NO. 27 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT WITH SITE TECHNOLOGY, INC. FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PICKLEBALL COURTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funds can be used to assist with modifications to public facilities for limited clientele residents, such as senior citizens, and in low-to-moderate income areas; and

WHEREAS, Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant Avenue, serves as a community center that administers parks and recreation programming targeting the senior citizen population of the City; and

WHEREAS, Harrington Field, located at 2610 Oakwood Drive, is located in a low-to-moderate income area of the City of Cuyahoga Falls according to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation desires to install two (2) regulation sized pickleball courts at Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant Avenue, which targets programming to the city's senior citizen population and two (2) regulation sized pickleball courts at Harrington Field, located at 2610 Oakwood Drive, which is located in a low-to-moderate income area of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls issued a Request for Proposals to construct the aforesaid pickleball courts; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Loan and Grant Review Committee approved the Mayor to enter into a contract with Site Technology, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$178,988.00 for the installation of said pickleball courts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to enter into a CDBG Agreement with Site Technology, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$178,988.00 for the installation of said pickleball courts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a CDBG agreement with Site Technology, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$178,988 for the installation of two (2) regulation sized pickleball courts at Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant

2610 Oakwood Drive.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payments from the CDBG Fund, line item Capital Outlay for same.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
