8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
9 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR  
10 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPAIR  
11 AND RESURFACING OF CHESTNUT BOULEVARD FROM  
12 STATE ROAD TO 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET, AND DECLARING AN  
13 EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and  
16 State of Ohio:



18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
19 or contracts, according to law, for the repair and resurfacing of Chestnut Boulevard from  
20 State Road to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.



22 Section 2. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
23 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any  
24 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
25 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
28 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
29 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
30 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in  
31 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107  
32 of the Codified Ordinances.

33  
34 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
35 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
36 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
37 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take  
38 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise  
39 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
