7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH SIEMENS INDUSTRY
10 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A REFURBISHED SIEMENS
11 BREAKER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
12

13 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls Electric Department currently has six similar
14 breakers at the Valley Substation; and

15
16 WHEREAS, one of these breakers is out-of-service and currently being repaired; and

17
18 WHEREAS, this refurbished breaker would be purchased as a spare, in case of a future
19 failure; and

20
21 WHEREAS, Siemens Industry is the sole source provider of this equipment.
22

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
24 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

26 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
27 contracts, without competitive bidding, with Siemens Industry for the purchase of a
28 refurbished Siemens breaker.
29

30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from
31 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
32

33 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
35 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
36 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
37

38 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
39 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
40 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
41 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
42 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
43


44 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
45 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
46 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote
47 of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in
48 force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
