AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING,
WITH STRYKER MEDICAL FOR THE PREVENTATIVE
MAINTENANCE OF LIFE-SAVING EQUIPMENT USED
BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City purchased Stryker Medical equipment for use by the Fire
Department; and

WHEREAS, this equipment must be inspected and maintained on a regular
basis; and

WHEREAS, although the annual maintenance charge does not exceed the
threshold for competitive bidding, the total contract five-year contract will exceed
\$50,000, requiring Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
contracts, without competitive bidding, with Stryker Medical for the preventative
maintenance of live-saving equipment used by the Fire Department for a period
not to exceed five years.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
payment for same from the General Fund, Fire Department, line item Other
Operations for a period not to exceed five years.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open
meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience


51 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
52 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
53 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
54 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
55 at the earliest period allowed by law.
