8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
9 ENTER INTO A SUBAWARD GRANT AGREEMENT
10 WITH THE INSTITUTE FOR INTERGOVERNMENTAL
11 RESEARCH FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE SECURE
12 AND RESPONSIBLE DRUG DISPOSAL PROGRAM IN
13 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$99,774 FOR THE
14 PURCHASE OF DRUG DISPOSAL BAGS AND TO MAKE
15 THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME,
16 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

18 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls Police Department applied for a
19 subaward grant through the Institute for Intergovernmental Research for the
20 acquisition of drug disposal bags on behalf of the Summit County Community
21 Partnership; and

23 WHEREAS, on April 1, 2021, the subaward grant was awarded to the City of
24 Cuyahoga Falls Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$99,774, to be
25 used for the purchase of drug disposal bags and other associated costs of the
26 project; and

28 WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase appropriations in the General Fund,
29 Police, line item Other Operations by \$99,774.

30
31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
32 Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

34 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement
35 with the Institute for Intergovernmental Research to be used for the purchase of
36 drug disposal bags on behalf of the Summit County partnership and other
37 associated costs with administering the Comprehensive Secure and Responsible
38 Drug Disposal Program.

40 Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to increase
41 appropriations in the General Fund, Police, line item Other Operations by
42 \$99,774 and make payment from the same.



44 Section 3. The Mayor, Director of Finance, Chief of Police, Director of Law,
45 and any other public officials, individually or collectively as may be appropriate,
46 are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents and do all other
47 things as necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or
48 requirements of the Comprehensive Secure and Responsible Drug Disposal
49 Program and this ordinance.

50 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
51 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
52 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
53 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

55 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
56 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
57 open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
58 of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to
59 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
60 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

62 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
63 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
64 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
65 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or
66 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
67 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
68 at the earliest period allowed by law.
