5 ORDINANCE NO. 36 - 2021

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF LAW TO  
8 ENTER INTO A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN THE CASE OF  
9 B.W. ET AL. V. CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN  
10 EMERGENCY.

11  
12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State  
13 of Ohio, that:

14  
15 Section 1. The Director of Law is hereby authorized to execute a settlement agreement in the  
16 case of *B.W., et al. v. City of Cuyahoga Falls*, Summit County Court of Common Pleas Case No. CV-  
17 2020-03-1143, on the basis of the proposal negotiated and presented to City Council on May \_\_\_\_,  
18 2021.

19  
20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
21 from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Other Operations.

22  
23 Section 3. The Director of Law, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute and file such  
24 pleadings and documents with the court or other agencies, including, without limitation, a  
25 stipulated judgment entry and any other pleadings necessary to effectuate the intent of the parties  
26 as set forth in the proposed settlement agreement.

28 Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent  
29 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and  
30 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31  
32 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
33 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all  
34 deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in  
35 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of  
36 the Codified Ordinances.

38 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
41 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
43 period allowed by law.
