3 CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO

5 ORDINANCE NO. 41 - 2023

6  
7 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A DESIGNATED OUTDOOR  
8 REFRESHMENT AREA KNOWN AS THE DOWNTOWN  
9 CUYAHOGA FALLS DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT  
10 AREA, ENACTING REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN  
11 EMERGENCY.

12  
13 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §4301.82 permits the City of Cuyahoga Falls to create  
14 and approve an application for a “Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area” (“DORA”)  
15 within its corporate limits; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, on February 24, 2023 Mayor Donald Walters applied to Cuyahoga Falls  
18 City Council in compliance with R.C. §4301.82(B), for approval of a DORA in a specified  
19 section of the City of Cuyahoga Falls. The DORA application is attached and incorporated  
20 herein as Exhibit A; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. §4301.82(C) and (F)(2), notice of the filing of the DORA  
23 application was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City; and

24  
25 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 17, 2023 during which public  
26 testimony was solicited; and

27  
28 WHEREAS, the DORA application as submitted to include the premises of the permit  
29 holders located at the street addresses in Section V of Exhibit A, meets the requirements  
30 of R.C. §4301.82(B)(1-5).

31  
32 WHEREAS, approval of the proposed DORA will serve to enhance the experience of  
33 both residents and visitors within Downtown Cuyahoga Falls.

34  
35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
36 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

37  
38 Section 1. That Council hereby approves the DORA Application as having met the  
39 requirements of R.C. §4301.82(B)(1-5) and approves the establishment of a Downtown  
40 Cuyahoga Falls Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area comprised of the area as depicted  
41 on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, such area to include and  
42 encompass the premises of the permit holders located at the street addresses listed in  
43 Section V of Exhibit A as required to be included pursuant to R.C. §4301.82(F)(1)(a).

44  
45 Section 2. Council determines that all public notice requirements of R.C. §4301.82  
46 prior to the passage of this Ordinance have been met.

47  
48 Section 3. In order to ensure public health and safety and in accordance with R.C.  
49 §4301.82(F)(1)(b), the number, spacing, and type of signage designating the DORA  
50 boundary shall be as set forth on page 3 of Exhibit A.

51 Section 4. The DORA encompasses not fewer than four (4) qualified permit holders, all  
52 of which are identified in Section V of Exhibit A, by business name, address, liquor  
53 permit type and liquor permit number. Also included in Section III of Exhibit A and in  
54 accordance with R.C. §4301.82(F)(1)(c), are the hours of operation for the DORA, which  
55 will apply to all activities within the DORA, only as may be limited or suspended by  
56 approval of City special event planning or at the request of City safety forces. Hours of  
57 operation shall be Sunday through Saturday from the hours of 10:00 am to 10:00 pm.  
58

59 Section 5. The Public Health and Safety Plan as described in Section VII of Exhibit A,  
60 is hereby approved as meeting the requirements of R.C. §4301.82(F)(1)(d), including the  
61 manner in which the number of personnel needed to carry out the plan shall be  
62 determined.  
63

64 Section 6. The Sanitation Plan that will help maintain the appearance and public  
65 health of the area as described in Section VII of Exhibit A is hereby approved as meeting  
66 the requirements of R.C. §4301.82(F)(1)(e) and 4301.82(F)(1)(f), including the manner in  
67 which the number of personnel needed to carry out the plan shall be determined.  
68

69 Section 7. As is required by R.C. §4301.82(F)(1)(g), beer, wine and intoxicating liquor  
70 shall only be served in plastic cups which shall be provided by the qualified permit  
71 holders in a readily-identified 16-ounce clear recyclable cup that identifies the DORA  
72 approved labeling. These cups and labeling will be purchased from the Downtown  
73 Partnership by the permit holders.  
74

75 Section 8. The Clerk of Council is hereby instructed to forward a copy of this  
76 Ordinance to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control and to the investigative unit of the Ohio  
77 Department of Public Safety, all in accordance with R.C. §4301.82(C) and 4301.82(F)(3).  
78

79 Section 9. The Director of Law is hereby authorized to make any necessary corrections  
80 to the application to comply with this ordinance or State Law.  
81

82 Section 10. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
83 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
84 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
85 hereby ratified and confirmed.

87 Section 11. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
88 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
89 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
90 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in  
91 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of  
92 the Codified Ordinances.  
93

94 Section 12. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
95 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
96 City of Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
97 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
98 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force  
99 at the earliest period allowed by law.

**APPLICATION TO THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS CITY  
COUNCIL**

- for the establishment of a -

**DOWNTOWN CUYAHOGA FALLS DESIGNATED  
OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA (DORA)**



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## **I. INTRODUCTION AND SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION**

Section 4301.82 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) authorizes municipalities over 50,000 in population to create a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area or “DORA” up to 640 acres. In order to consider the creation of a DORA, the Executive Officer of the City of Cuyahoga Falls must file an application with the Cuyahoga Falls City Council (City Council), which meets certain statutory requirements. The application filing must be advertised for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation. Not earlier than 30 days, but not later than 60 days, after the initial publication of the notice, the City Council may approve or disapprove of the application by ordinance or resolution.

The creation of the DORA is intended to serve as an economic tool to attract patrons to downtown Cuyahoga Falls and highlight the area as a destination for dining and entertainment. The purpose of this application is to request City Council approve a DORA in Cuyahoga Falls.

The Downtown Cuyahoga Falls Partnership initiated the request for a DORA after it received multiple requests for it from its partner and volunteer base. All participating liquor permit establishments will be required to execute an agreement with the Partnership stating that the establishment will purchase 16-ounce clear recyclable cups for and the identifying stickers for DORA cups from the Partnership. The Partnership will also be purchasing door decals for all establishments within the proposed DORA boundary. The door decals will allow patrons to recognize which establishments are selling DORA drinks and whether retail establishments will allow DORA cups on their premises.

The Downtown Cuyahoga Falls Partnership will be responsible for administering any DORA related materials, including DORA cups and DORA stickers. Any participating business with a liquor permit will be required to enter into an agreement with the Downtown Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for the provision of these supplies.

## **II. BOUNDARIES**

In accordance with O.R.C. 4301.82(B)(1)(a), the boundaries of the DORA are depicted on the following map and described as follows. A list of the street addresses within the DORA are also attached. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is a chartered municipal corporation with a population of 51,114 (2020 Census Data).



### **Signage Defining Boundaries of DORA**

The City will supply Entrance/Exit signs to the DORA at the major access points on Front Street, Second Street, Portage Trail, and Broad Boulevard.

### **III. HOURS OF OPERATION**

The DORA be operable Sunday through Saturday from 10 am until 10 pm.

### **IV. NATURE OF ESTABLISHMENTS**

In accordance with O.R.C. 4301.82(B)(2), the nature and type of establishments that will be located within the DORA are listed below.

The types of establishments located within the DORA are primarily in dining, retail, services or office sectors. Examples include:

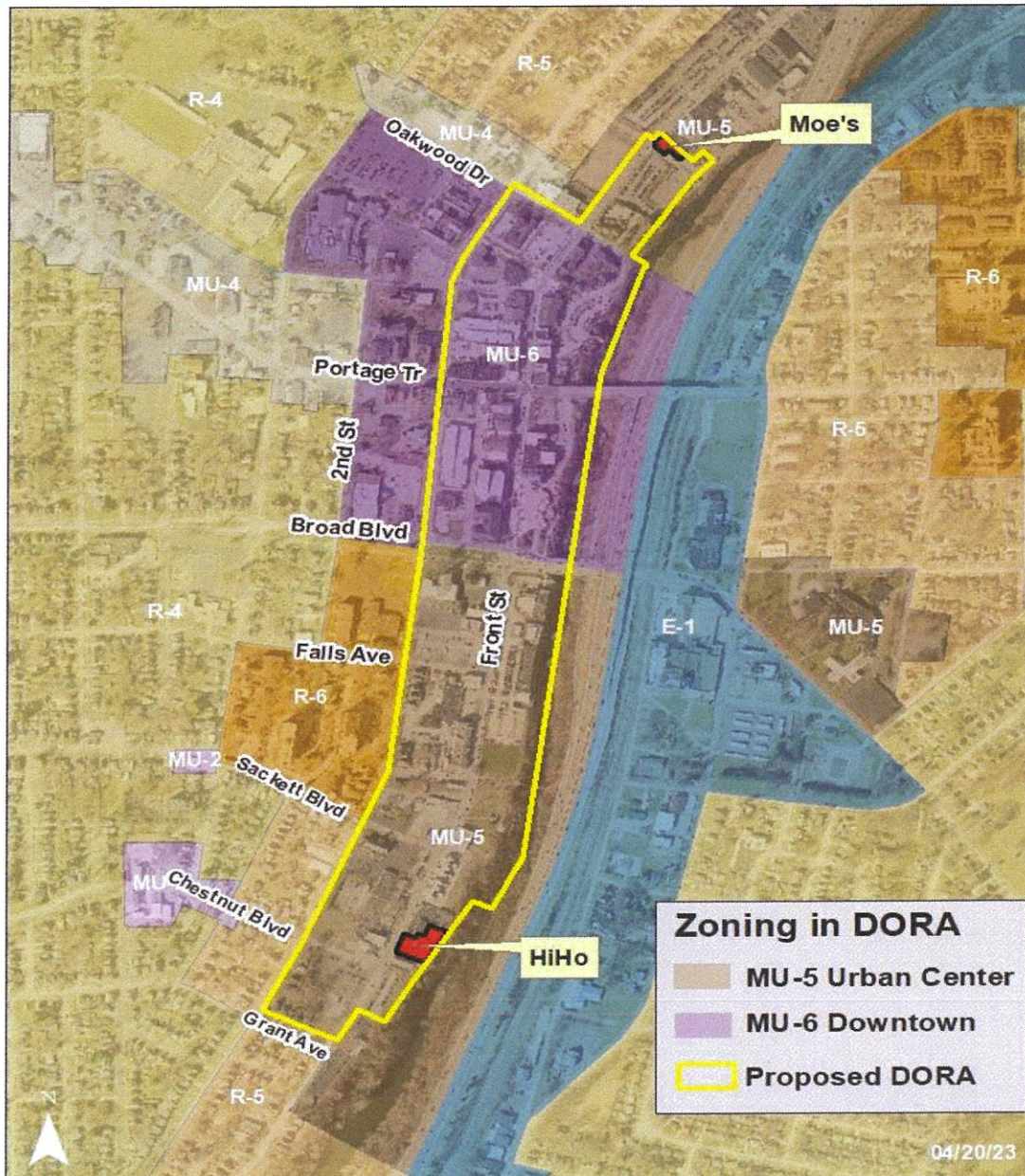

## VI. LAND USE AND ZONING

In accordance with O.R.C. 4301.82(B)(4), the uses of land within area designated for the DORA is zoned MU-5- Urban Center and MU-6- Downtown and is in accordance with Cuyahoga Falls' master zoning plan:



## **VII. PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY**

### **Ensuring Compliance with Minor Liquor Laws:**

It will be the responsibility of the qualified permit holder to enforce all applicable liquor laws, including minor liquor laws.

### **Outdoor Trash and Litter Control:**

City of Cuyahoga Falls staff would be responsible for trash collection in the DORA. Recycle containers will be available to dispose of the recyclable DORA cups. Staffing levels, trash cans and recyclable bins would be monitored and adjusted as needed. Businesses in the DORA will be encouraged to provide their own recycle containers for DORA cups as well.

### **Special Events:**

The City of Cuyahoga Falls requires that each special event using City property receive a permit from the City. As is the City's practice, each event will be reviewed as required in the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls. Permit requirements may differ between events depending on their size, layout, use of right of way, and program. However, each event will be reviewed to ensure that adequate sanitation, signage, and public safety requirements are established. The necessity of portable bathrooms, handicap accessibility, pedestrian mobility, police, fire and emergency medical ingress and egress, crowd control, DORA boundary management and trash management (dumpsters, cans, pick-up, etc.) will be addressed. Event organizers may be required to pay for special duty officers or overtime for public service or safety workers if necessary, to ensure adequate health, public and safety requirements. If the special event includes the sale of alcoholic beverages, the event organizers can request that the City suspend the DORA for the duration of the special event. Special events where the DORA will be suspended or modified include the Irish Festival, Festa Italiana, and Oktoberfest and any other city sponsored events as deemed necessary.

## **City of Cuyahoga Falls DORA Safety Plan:**

The Safety Plan will help maintain public safety within the DORA, and designate the number of personnel needed to execute the Safety Plan. This will be accomplished in the following manner.

Current Public Safety personnel are adequate to maintain public safety within the DORA district. The City of Cuyahoga Falls Police Department (CFPD) currently has the ability and manpower which will enable it to maintain public safety within the DORA to include the Front Street business district. CFPD has flexibility when deploying resources and has years of experience dealing with all of the downtown events.

### **Staffing for DORA would consist of:**

1. Utilizing the current scheduled shifts of Cuyahoga Falls Safety Forces giving them the ability to actively patrol the DORA and have a visible presence in the assigned area.
2. During pre-planned or known special events that will increase the activity in the DORA area the CFPD will seek to have the organizations involved with the event help supplement the manning needed to effectively police the DORA area. CFPD will seek payment from such organizations for extra duty officer(s) as needed. The officer(s) primary responsibility would be the Front Street area where the DORA is located.
3. All Safety Forces supervisors or OIC's (Officer's in Charge) have the flexibility to call in additional staffing for emergency situations or if large crowds start to get out of control.

### **Amendments and Possible Revocation:**

City staff, business leaders, Downtown Cuyahoga Falls Partnership representatives, elected officials (including but not limited to the Ward councilpersons of the DORA area), and City residents located in the DORA would regularly meet to discuss the impacts of the DORA and recommend potential changes to Council including hours and days of operation up to and including the possible revocation of the DORA if its negatives are considered to outweigh its benefits or if it is no longer considered to be an economic benefit to the City. Council will have the final say in enacting any changes to the DORA.
