5 ORDINANCE NO. 44 - 2022

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO  
8 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE  
9 BIDDING, WITH OHIO DRILLING COMPANY INC. FOR THE INSPECTION,  
10 CLEANING, AND ASSOCIATED REPAIRS FOR CITY WELL #5, AND WELL  
11 #21 FOR THE WATER DIVISION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12  
13 WHEREAS, the repair work identified during inspection needs to be completed in conjunction with  
14 cleaning to put each well back in service as soon as possible; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, Ohio Drilling has performed work on the City's drinking water wells since at least 1937;  
17 and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the City's goal is to establish a regular cycle for inspecting, cleaning and repairing each of  
20 the 18 drinking water wells.

21  
22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit  
23 and State of Ohio, that:

24  
25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,  
26 without competitive bidding, with Ohio Drilling Company Inc. for the inspection, cleaning, and associated  
27 repairs for City Well #5 and Well #21 for the Water Division.



29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Water  
30 Fund, line item Other Operations for the inspection and cleaning, and Capital Outlay for the repairs.

32 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent  
33 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which  
34 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

35  
36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to  
37 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations  
38 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to  
39 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the  
40 Codified Ordinances.

41  
42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation  
43 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the  
44 inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or  
45 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the  
46 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
