7 AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES
8 TO THE CUYAHOGA FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND
9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform
12 with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

14 WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by
15 Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

17 WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company
18 to prepare and publish such revision which is before Council.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
21 of Summit and State of Ohio:

23 Section 1. That the ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, of a general and
24 permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes,
25 titles, chapters and sections within the 2021 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are

91 Section 3. The complete text of the sections listed above are set forth in full in the current
92 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances. The listing above of each new section by reference
93 to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

95 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and concerning
96 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council,
97 and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal
98 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
99 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

101 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
102 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
103 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds
104 of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
105 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
106 earliest period allowed by law.


