7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PADDLE
10 PARK AND THE EXPANSION OF THE EXISTING CORNER PLAZA
11 LOCATED AT 2170 FRONT STREET, AND INCREASING
12 APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
15 Ohio:

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17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the construction of Paddle Park and the expansion of the existing
19 corner plaza located at 2170 Front Street, and to increase appropriations.
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21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the
22 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay, by \$318,000.00 and to make payment for same.
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24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
25 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
26 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
27 confirmed.
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
29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
30 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
31 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
32 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent
33 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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35 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
36 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
37 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely
38 and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two
39 thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
40 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
41 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
