7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC

10 OF A WATER SYSTEM MASTER PLAN, AND DECLARING AN

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14 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls water system is required to maintain compliance with  
15 OEPA and USEPA rules and regulations; and  
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17 WHEREAS, the City strives to develop and maintain a comprehensive model of the water  
18 system to better plan for new and replacement water projects; and  
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20 WHEREAS, maintenance of the water distribution system is a crucial component to providing  
21 continued service to customers while minimizing disruptions; and  
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23 WHEREAS, increasing risks to the City’s water system from natural and man-made hazards,  
24 acts of vandalism, terrorism, and cyberterrorism must be assessed and prepared for to the  
25 highest degree possible; and

27 WHEREAS, the City seeks to compile a complete and comprehensive list of all assets  
28 associated with its water treatment and distribution systems.  
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30 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
31 County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:  
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33 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to enter into a Professional Services  
34 Agreement with CT Consultants in an amount not to exceed \$270,000.00 for the study and  
35 creation of a Water System Master Plan.  
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37 Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to make payment for same from the Water  
38 Fund, line item, Other Operations.  
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40 Section 3. The Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Public Service, Director of Law, and  
41 any other public officials, individually and/or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized  
42 to prepare and execute such other documents and do all other things as are necessary or  
43 incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of this legislation.  
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
45 Section 4. Any ordinance or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
46 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
47 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
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49 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
50 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
51 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
52 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
53 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


54 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the  
55 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
56 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of  
57 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
58 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the  
59 earliest period allowed by law.
