7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS  
9 WITH CORE & MAIN LP, EAST JORDAN IRON WORKS,  
10 FERGUSON ENTERPRISES INC., AND TRUMBULL  
11 INDUSTRIES, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, FOR THE  
12 PURCHASE OF SERVICES, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND  
13 EQUIPMENT TO BE USED IN INFRASTRUCTURE  
14 PROJECTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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16 WHEREAS, City departments and divisions must purchase services, materials,  
17 supplies, and equipment throughout the year to operate effectively; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the public bidding process can slow the procurement of goods and  
20 services necessary to City operations; and

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22 WHEREAS, with some vendors, although no specific expenditure for their services,  
23 materials, supplies, and equipment are expected to exceed the competitive bidding  
24 amount threshold individually, collectively these costs are projected to exceed the  
25 competitive bidding limit.

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
28 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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30 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
31 or contracts, without competitive bidding, with the vendors listed below, for the  
32 purchase of the materials, supplies, and equipment to be used in infrastructure projects  
33 in an amount not to exceed \$355,000.00:

36 - East Jordan Iron Works  
37 - Ferguson Enterprises Inc.  
38 - Trumbull Industries  
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40 Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized to make payment for same out of  
41 the Water Fund, line items Capital Outlay and Materials and Supplies.  
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43 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
44 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
45 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and  
46 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

47 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
48 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open


49 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
50 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in  
51 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107  
52 of the Codified Ordinances.  
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54 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
55 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
56 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the  
57 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall  
58 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;  
59 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
