7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT
9 COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH INTERNATIONAL ARMORED GROUP US,
10 INC. TO PURCHASE A TACTICAL VAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls Police Department requires a new tactical van, specially outfitted for
13 use by its officers; and

14
15 WHEREAS, International Armored Group US, Inc. is able to supply the van, complete this work,
16 provide the necessary items, and deliver the vehicle in a timely manner.

17
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
19 Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

20
21 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
22 without competitive bidding, with International Armored Group US, Inc to purchase a tactical van.

23
24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from
25 the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

27 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
29 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
30 and confirmed.

31
32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and concerning and
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
34 deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings
35 open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter
36 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
40 and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members
41 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
42 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
