9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD
10 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF
11 ONE HVAC UNIT AND A NIAGARA BUILDING AUTOMATION SYSTEM
12 UPGRADE TO BE INSTALLED AT THE NATATORIUM, AND DECLARING
13 AN EMERGENCY.

16 Whereas, the HVAC unit and operating system at the Natatorium are now over 17 years old and are
17 reaching the effective life cycle; and

18
19 Whereas, the replacement of the HVAC unit and operating system, with proper installation and
20 maintenance, will allow the Natatorium to modernize and replace a failing system.
21

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
23 and State of Ohio, that:
24

25 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts
26 for the purchase of one HVAC unit and a Niagara Building Automation System upgrade to be installed at
27 the Natatorium through the Sourcing Alliance bid or any other source having a price equal to or lower than
28 that provided by the Sourcing Alliance bid. Any requirement for competitive bidding is hereby suspended.
29

30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to increase appropriations in the
31 Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay by \$60,000, reduce Leisure Time Fund, Personal Services by
32 the same and make payment from Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

34 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
35 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
36 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
37 and confirmed.

39 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
40 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
41 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
42 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
43

44 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
45 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
46 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
47 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
48 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
