7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO.
9 8533 WITH THE THRASHER GROUP, INC., AND DECLARING AN
10 EMERGENCY.

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12 WHEREAS, the City followed the procedures set forth in Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.65
13 to 153.73 in selecting a professional design services firm for the design of roadway improvements
14 at State Road/Wyoga Lake Road/Seasons Road; and

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16 WHEREAS, after review of all the proposals submitted to the City, The Thrasher Group, Inc.
17 (Thrasher) was selected as the most qualified for the project; and

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19 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of the Board of Control on or about May 2, 2022, the
20 Director of Public Service entered into Contract No. 8533, with Thrasher to provide Professional
21 Engineering services for the design of roadway improvements at State Road/Wyoga Lake
22 Road/Seasons Road (the "Project"); and

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24 WHEREAS, for the Project to proceed, the City desires to continue Professional Engineering
25 services which will benefit the Project.

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
28 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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30 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a modification of
31 Contract No. 8533, with Thrasher in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00. The total contract
32 price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$350,000.00.

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34 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
35 same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.


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37 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
38 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
39 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
40 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
43 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
44 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
45 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
46 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


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48 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
49 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
50 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
51 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
52 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
53 period allowed by law.
