ORDINANCE NO. 72 -2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH EMERALD TRANSFORMER FOR PCB REMEDIATION IN THE ELECTRIC VAULT AT 2800 13TH STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the former Newberry Elementary School located at 2800 13th Street is scheduled for demolition in the Fall of 2022; and

WHEREAS, there is an electric vault with PCB contamination which must be remediated prior to demolition; and

WHEREAS, Emerald Transformer is qualified to remediate and dispose of PCB contaminated equipment and materials within the guidelines set by the Ohio EPA and Division of Materials and Waste Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with Emerald Transformer for PCB remediation in the electric vault at 2800 13th Street in a total amount not to exceed \$130,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
