7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF OVERHEAD
10 AND UNDERGROUND POWER LINES ON FEEDER 801, FEEDER
11 802, AND FEEDER 304 TO PREPARE FOR 12.5KV CONVERSION,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, Feeder 801, Feeder 802, and Feeder 304 have equipment that has reached the end of its
16 expected useful life and must be replaced; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Feeder 801, Feeder 802, and Feeder 304 have under-rated electrical equipment that
19 needs to be upgraded to make the feeders ready for conversion from 4160 V to 12.5 kV; and

20
21 WHEREAS, the Substation for feeders 801 and 802 needs to be retired and this work will enable this
22 to occur; and

23
24 WHEREAS, the Feeder 801, 802, and 304 load will be moved to Feeders 803, 804, and 401.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
27 Summit and State of Ohio:

28
29 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
30 contracts, according to law, for the construction of overhead and underground power lines on Feeder
31 801, Feeder 802, and Feeder 304 to replace or eliminate aged equipment and under-voltage rated
32 electrical equipment with properly rated electrical equipment to make the lines ready to be converted to
33 12.5 kV.



36 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
37 from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

39 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
40 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
41 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
42 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

44 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
45 to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
47 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including
48 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

49 This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the
50 public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
51 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed
52 to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
53 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
