7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.01(b) OF THE CODIFIED
8 ORDINANCES, RELATING TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TRAFFIC
9 COMMITTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, currently, legislation exists that names a representative of the Communications
12 Department to the Cuyahoga Falls Traffic Committee; and

13
14 WHEREAS, due to organizational changes within the City, a representative from the Information or
15 Technology Services Department is needed on the Traffic Committee to best address technical traffic issues.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
19 and State of Ohio, that:

21 Section 1. Section 145.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls is hereby amended
22 to read in full as follows (new text double underlined; deleted text in ~~striketrough~~):

24 The members of the Committee shall be as follows: one member of Council; a representative of the
25 Police Department; a representative of the Law Department; a representative of the Engineering
26 Department; a representative of the ~~Communications~~ Information or Technology Services
27 Department; a representative of the Street Department; and one resident of the City to be
28 appointed by the Mayor.

30 The members of the Committee shall meet and elect a chairman and hold regular meetings to be
31 called at the time and place to be determined by the chairman.

34 Section 2. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
35 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
36 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

38 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
39 the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of
40 this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
41 public, in compliance with all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

43 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
44 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
45 inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
46 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
47 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
