7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF
8 SAFETY, TO SELL TO AKRON CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL POLICE
9 DEPARTMENT A USED 2016 FORD UTILITY INTERCEPTOR SUV,
10 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, the City possesses a 2016 Ford Utility Interceptor SUV that is no longer needed for
13 use by the City of Cuyahoga Falls Police Department.; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Akron Children's Hospital has offered to purchase the vehicle for three thousand
16 dollars (\$3,000) for use by its police department; and

17
18 WHEREAS, a directed auction was conducted for other municipalities but there was no interest
19 in the vehicle from other municipalities due to its mileage; and

20
21 WHEREAS, \$3,000 is the reasonable value of the vehicle based on its mileage.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
24 Summit and State of Ohio, that:



26 Section 1. The Mayor, as Safety Director, is hereby authorized to sell for the sum of \$3,000
27 to Akron Children's Hospital, a used police car for use by its police department. City Council hereby
28 finds that the price is the reasonable value of the vehicle based on its mileage.

30 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
31 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
32 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
33 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

35 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
36 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all
37 deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in
38 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of
39 the Codified Ordinances.

41 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
43 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
44 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
45 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
46 period allowed by law.
