9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION
10 BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR REPAIRS TO THE PAVILION
12 LOCATED AT 2085 FRONT STREET, AND DECLARING AN
13 EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, the stairs and balcony at the Pavilion located at 2085 Front Street are now reaching
16 their effective life cycle and need to be replaced; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the repairs to the stairs and balcony at the Pavilion will ensure a safe and stable
19 environment around the building for many years in the future.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
22 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

23
24 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
25 contracts, according to law, for repairs to the Pavilion located at 2085 Front Street.

27 Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
28 from the Recreation Levy Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

29
30 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
31 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
32 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
33 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

34
35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
36 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
37 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
38 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter
39 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

40
41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
43 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
44 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
45 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
46 period allowed by law.
