ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH CORE AND MAIN FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER SERVICE LINE CONSTRUCTION SUPPLIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Core & Main has competitive pricing on many required items for water service line installation; and

WHEREAS, while no specific expenditure for these service line supplies has exceeded the threshold for the competitive bidding amount this calendar year, collectively these expenditures may soon exceed the competitive bidding amount of \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Core and Main for the purchase of water service line construction supplies.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Water Fund, line item Other Operations.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
