6 ORDINANCE NO. 94 - 2021

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
9 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION  
10 BLOCK GRANT FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON  
11 METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY, FOR THE  
12 RESURFACING OF HUDSON DRIVE, BETWEEN FRONT STREET  
13 AND GRAHAM ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
14

15 WHEREAS, the City Engineer has identified the need for and proposes the resurfacing of  
16 Hudson Drive between Front Street and Graham Road; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) is conducting a  
19 competitive grant process under which Federal Surface Transportation Funds may be made  
20 available to partially support construction costs for City sponsored projects.  
21

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
23 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
24

25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to apply for and accept financial  
26 assistance in the form of a grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation, through the Akron  
27 Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS), for the purpose of supporting construction  
28 costs related to the Project, as follows:  
29

30 Project Name: Hudson Drive Resurfacing  
31

32 Description: From Front Street to Graham Road, approximately 6,300-feet; resurface  
33 roadway including grind and pave three-inches (3") of asphalt pavement, restripe pavement  
34 markings and replace traffic loops.  
35

36 Estimated Construction Cost: \$958,700.  
37

38 Section 2. This Council's authorization is granted with the following understandings:  
39

- 40 A. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of preliminary  
41 engineering.
- 42 B. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost of those features  
43 requested by the City which are not eligible for Federal participation.
- 44 C. The Federal share will assume eighty percent (80%) of the construction cost of the  
45 improvement not to exceed \$700,000. The City will be responsible for the local  
46 share.
- 47 D. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is in receipt of and acknowledges the applicability of  
48 the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" to this funding request.
- 49 E. The Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized and directed to make payment  
50 for same from the Capital Projects Fund.

51 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
52 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions  
53 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and  
54 confirmed.

55  
56 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
57 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
58 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
59 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including  
60 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

61  
62 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
63 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
64 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of  
65 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
66 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the  
67 earliest period allowed by law.
