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8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION

11 METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY, FOR THE
12 RECONSTRUCTION OF WYOGA LAKE ROAD, BETWEEN EAST
13 STEELS CORNERS ROAD AND SEASONS ROAD, AND
14 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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17 WHEREAS, the City Engineer has identified the need for and proposes the reconstruction of
18 Wyoga Lake Road between East Steels Corners Road and Seasons Road; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study is conducting a competitive
21 grant process under which Federal Surface Transportation Funds may be made available to
22 partially support construction costs for City sponsored projects.
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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
25 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to apply for and accept financial
28 assistance in the form of a Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Funds from the U.S.
29 Department of Transportation, through the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study, for
30 the purpose of supporting construction costs related to the Project, as follows:
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32 Project Name: Wyoga Lake Road Reconstruction
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34 Description: From East Steels Corners Road to Seasons Road, approximately 7,900-feet;
35 reconstruct and widen roadway to include the addition of a center turn lane, multi-use path,
36 and traffic signals where warranted.
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38 Estimated Construction Cost: \$7,500,000.
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40 Section 2. This Council's authorization is granted with the following understandings:
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- 42 A. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of preliminary
43 engineering.
- 44 B. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost of those features
45 requested by the City which are not eligible for Federal participation.
- 46 C. The Federal share will assume eighty percent (80%) of the construction cost of the
47 improvement not to exceed \$6,000,000. The City will be responsible for the local
48 share.
- 49 D. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is in receipt of and acknowledges the applicability of
50 the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" to this funding request.
- 51 E. The Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized and directed to make payment
52 for same from the Capital Projects Fund.

53 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
54 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
55 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
56 confirmed.
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58 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
59 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
60 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
61 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
62 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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64 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
65 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
66 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
67 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
68 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
69 earliest period allowed by law.
