7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 36-2022 TO
8 AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 8542 WITH DANT
10 CLAYTON AND MAKING THE NECESSARY
11 APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME, AND DECLARING
12 AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, the original Dant Clayton quote did not include seatbacks for the
15 benching seating portion of this project which are necessary for this venue.

16
17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
18 Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

19
20 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a modification of
21 Contract No. 8542 with Dant Clayton, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00.
22 The total contract price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed
23 \$68,900.

24
25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase
26 appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line
27 item Capital Outlay and reduce Community Development Block Grant Fund,
28 CDBG, line item Other Operations by \$10,000, and make payment from the
29 Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Capital Outlay.

30
31 Section 3. Any ordinance or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
32 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
33 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
34 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

35
36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
37 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
38 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
39 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings
40 open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent
41 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

43 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
44 necessary of the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience,
45 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and

46 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or
47 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
48 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
49 at the earliest period allowed by law.
