8 A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING PASSAGE
9 OF ISSUE 4, THE CUYAHOGA FALLS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT LEVY,
10 AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022,
11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has nine public schools in the City of Cuyahoga
14 Falls and the Village of Silver Lake, serving over 4,000 students; and

15
16 WHEREAS, a properly funded public school system is foundational to civic and economic success;
17 and

19 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has caused a proposed levy to be placed on
20 the November 8, 2022 ballot as Issue 4; and

22 WHEREAS, these funds will be used, in part, to make improvements to the elementary schools for
23 the safety and comfort of the students; and

25 WHEREAS, this levy is a renewal, not an increase, commencing in 2023 and continuing for 5 years.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
28 Summit and State of Ohio, that:



30 Section 1. The Council and Administration express their support for the Cuyahoga Falls City
31 School District and urge the passage of Issue 4 at the November 8, 2022 General Election.

33 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
34 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
35 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were
36 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent
37 applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
41 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
42 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
43 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
44 law.
