RESOLUTION NO. 2. -2021

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MAYOR'S SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2022 SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS TO COMPLETE THE GORGE TERRACE STREET TRANSFORMATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure is seeking funding submission applications for Surface Transportation Projects, through the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for the Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Surface Transportation Authorization legislation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need for, and proposes capital improvements to public infrastructure, to wit: completing the Gorge Terrace Street Transformation Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council expresses support for the City's application for funding through the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for the Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Surface Transportation Authorization legislation, for Surface Transportation Projects located within the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council supports the Mayor's submission of an application to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure for funding of Surface Transportation Projects through the Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Surface Transportation Authorization legislation for the purpose of completing the Gorge Terrace Street Transformation Project.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
