8 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR
9 AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A
10 GRANT OR LOAN FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS
11 COMMISSION FOR REPLACEMENT OF 6" AND 8" WATER
12 MAINS IN OAKWOOD DRIVE, FROM GRAHAM ROAD TO
13 MONROE AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), through its State Capital
17 Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program, provides
18 financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public
19 infrastructure; and

21 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and
22 proposes a capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: replacement of 6" and
23 8" water mains with an 8" water main, including all necessary appurtenances, in
24 Oakwood Drive, from Graham Road to Monroe Avenue; and

26 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement hereinabove described is considered to
27 be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.
28

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
30 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
31

32 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and accept financial
33 assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Commission for the
34 purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of replacement of 6" and 8"
35 water mains with an 8" water main, including all necessary appurtenances, in Oakwood
36 Drive, from Graham Road to Monroe Avenue, by means of the State Capital Improvement
37 Program (SCIP) and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) administered
38 by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

40 Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as may be
41 necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance mentioned herein.
42

43 Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified copy of
44 this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.
45

46 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
47 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open
48 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
49 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

50 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
51 of the Codified Ordinances.

52

53 Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
54 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
55 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
56 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
57 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
58 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
