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8 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR
9 AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A

11 COMMISSION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF WEST
12 PORTAGE TRAIL EXTENSION, FROM STATE ROAD TO
13 NORTHAMPTON ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), through its State Capital
16 Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program, provides
17 financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public
18 infrastructure; and
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20 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and proposes
21 a capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: PID 108084, SUM Portage Trail
22 Extension, Improvement of West Portage Trail Extension, from State Road to
23 Northampton Road; and
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25 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement hereinabove described is considered to be
26 a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.
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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
29 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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31 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and accept financial
32 assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Commission for the
33 purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of removal and replacement
34 of pavement, signage, light poles, and storm sewer as needed, to reconstruct the
35 roadway from State Road to Northampton Road, by means of the State Capital
36 Improvement Program (SCIP) and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP)
37 administered by the Ohio Public Works Commission.
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39 Section 2. The Mayor and any other necessary City official are hereby authorized to
40 enter into agreements as may be necessary to apply for and accept the financial
41 assistance mentioned herein.
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43 Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified copy of
44 this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.
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46 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
47 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open
48 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
49 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

50 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
51 of the Codified Ordinances.

53 Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
54 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
55 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
56 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
57 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
58 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
