## RESOLUTION NO. 6 - 2023

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DR. PATRICK BLAKESLEE AS THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON THE SUMMIT COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

 WHEREAS, Dr. Kristine Gill, having been appointed by the Mayor as the City of Cuyahoga Falls representative on the Summit County Combined General Health District Board of Health for a four-year term beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2025, has resigned from her position; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Dr. Patrick Blakeslee to complete the unexpired term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio that:

<u>Section 1.</u> Newly appointed Dr. Patrick Blakeslee is hereby designated to act on behalf of the City in the discharge of his duties as a Board Member for the remainder of the unexpired term ending December 31, 2025.

<u>Section 2.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 4.</u> This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
