Section 1. Council hereby expresses its support to join in Power a Clean Future Ohio (PCFO) so that the City can be recognized as a Power a Clean Future Community.

Section 2. Council appoints Parks and Recreation Superintendent Sara Kline and Council Member Mary Nichols-Rhodes, or their designees, to serve as the City's PCFO co-coordinators for implementation of the plan.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
