9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND
10 RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
11 CONTRACTS, AFTER PUBLICLY ADVERTISING FOR BIDS,
12 FOR KENNEDY PARK FIELD RENOVATIONS, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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15 WHEREAS, the baseball field backstops and fencing at Kennedy Park Fields 1, 2 and 4,
16 are now reaching their effective life cycles; and

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18 WHEREAS, the baseball field backstops replacement will ensure a safe and stable
19 environment on all of these baseball fields for many years in the future.

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
22 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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24 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
25 or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for Kennedy Park field renovations.

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27 Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the
28 Recreation Levy Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

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30 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
31 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
32 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
33 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.


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35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
36 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
37 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such
38 formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements
39 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
42 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
43 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
44 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
45 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be
46 in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
