6 ORDINANCE NO. 97 - 2023

8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE
9 BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC
10 CONTROL DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and
13 maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the
14 Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and

15
16 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic
17 Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

18
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
20 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

22 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control
23 File is hereby amended as follows:

- 24
25 1. Prohibit parking on the odd address side of Vancouver St. between 2031 and the
26 dead end to the north.
- 27
28 2. Request to update the Traffic File to include the following items at the Blossom
29 Glen subdivision:
 - 30 • Stop sign on Ensemble Drive at Keyser Parkway
 - 31 • Stop sign on Quartette Drive at Keyser Parkway
 - 32 • Stop sign on Lyrics Lane at Keyser Parkway
 - 33 • Stop signs on Symphony Street at both intersections with Keyser Parkway
 - 34 • Stop sign on Keyser Parkway, northbound at West Steels Corners Road
 - 35 • Install no parking signs on the even sides of Ensemble Drive, Quartette Lane
36 and Symphony Street
 - 37 • Install no parking signs on the even side of Keyser Parkway, between Chart
38 Road and West Steels Corners Road

40 3. Request to update the Traffic File to include the following item at the Timber
41 Creek subdivision:
 - 42 • Stop sign on Creekview Drive at Brookview Drive

44 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to note in the Traffic Control File
45 the proper legends.



47 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to cause the installation or removal of the
48 proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

49 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
50 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and
51 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
52 which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
53

54 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
55 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
56 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
57 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
58 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
59 of the Codified Ordinances.


61 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
62 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
63 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the
64 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
65 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
66 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


