8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS
9 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TO SELL TO
10 SOURCE PRODUCTS, INC., CERTAIN USED FIRE
11 DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, Source Products, Inc. is interested in purchasing used equipment that
15 is no longer needed for use by the Cuyahoga Falls Fire Department; and

16
17 WHEREAS, in exchange for the equipment, the City will receive a \$4,000 credit to
18 purchase medical supplies.

19
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
21 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22
23 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Safety, is authorized to sell obsolete Fire
24 Department equipment in exchange for a \$4,000.00 account credit to Source Products,
25 Inc., to be used towards the purchase of medical supplies, by the Cuyahoga Falls Fire
26 Department.

28 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
29 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
30 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
31 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
34 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
35 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
36 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
37 compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, including
38 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
41 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
42 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
43 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
44 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
45 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
